Remember to review your company's PPE policy and safe work procedures to know what PPE is needed for any task!

Protect yourself

Eye damage from projectiles, dust, particulates Wear safety glasses with side shields and UV Eye protection protection if needed and ultra-violet (UV) rays Exposure to harmful noise levels and hearing Wear hearing protection (ear muffs, ear plugs Hearing protection loss over time or both) when noise levels are above 85 dBA Head injuries from falling objects or lateral Wear hard hats with adjustable head band and Head protection impacts suspension Foot injuries from falling objects, punctures Wear CSA-approved safety footwear (look for Foot/ankle from sharp materials and sprain/strains the green triangle) with ankle support protection Injuries due to decreased visibility to other Wear reflective vests, jackets or other clothing **Visibility** workers, drivers and equipment operators to increase visibility to others so others notice you Print and review this talk with your staff, sign off and file for COR™ / SECOR audit purposes.
